County Receives Neighborhood Stabilization Funds

Mason, Michigan. The Ingham County Land Bank Fast Track Authority and the Ingham County Housing Commission has been awarded a \$300,000 grant from the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) and the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA).

The funds will be used for the acquisition and redevolpment of four (4) foreclosed or abandoned properties in the City of Mason

"Federal recovery dollars are starting to flow into our community and should quicken the pace of improvement of the recent housing crisis," said Eric Schertzing, Ingham County Treasurer and Chair of the Ingham County Land Bank. "The City of Mason has done a marvelous job to assist the County in obtaining these funds. We look forward to making the worst house on the block the best," Schertzing said.
